

Anaphylaxis Management

Course Description

The Anaphylaxis Management course delivers all of the essential principles, skills and knowledge in the first aid management of anaphylaxis including the use of the adrenaline auto-injector (e.g. Epi-pen). This course is approved by the Australian Children's Education & Care Quality Authority (ACECQA) to meet the anaphylaxis management training requirements of child care workers.

Course Content

- Signs and symptoms of an anaphylactic reaction
- First aid treatment for an anaphylactic reaction
- Evaluating first response to anaphylactic reaction
- Identifying individuals at risk of allergic reactions and anaphylaxis
- Developing individual anaphylaxis management plans
- Avoidance and preventative measures to take for children with severe allergies
- Managing severe allergic reactions, including the use of the adrenaline auto-injector (e.g. Epi-pen)

Entry Requirements

- Participants must be a minimum of 14 years of age on the date of final assessment
- It is highly recommended that all participants hold a current CPR certificate

Duration

2 hours including assessment.

Assessment

The course is assessed through demonstration, presentation and application of all elements of competency in the workplace. Participants will be required to complete activities that may include role-plays, oral and written questioning, practical demonstrations and perform scenarios.

Accreditation

Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive a nationally recognised statement of Attainment for the following unit of competency:

This course is approved by the Australian Children's Education & Care Quality Authority (ACECQA) to meet the asthma and anaphylaxis management training requirements of child care workers.

Course Content

- Signs and symptoms of asthma and an anaphylactic reaction
- Triggers that can cause an asthma attack
- Medication and delivery devices for the management of asthma
- Identifying potential asthma emergencies
- Treating a mild, moderate and severe asthma episode
- First aid assistance in an undiagnosed individual
- First aid treatment for an anaphylactic reaction
- Identifying individuals at risk of allergic reactions and anaphylaxis
- Developing individual anaphylaxis management plans
- Avoidance and preventative measures to take for children with severe allergies
- Managing severe allergic reactions, including the use of the adrenaline auto-injector (e.g. Epi-pen)

Entry Requirements

- Participants must be a minimum of 14 years of age on the date of final assessment
