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Subject:	2019 SLSNSW State Championships – Officials Age, Masters and Open

Introduction:

SLSNSW appreciates that the State Championships relies on our volunteers from clubs to stage the event in roles from officiating, safety and age/team management.

The State Championships is lacking the required officials to conduct the scheduled events as per the timetable. Unfortunately there is a shortage in both experience and the actual number of officials appointed across the Age, Masters and Open Championships.

At present, our Championship Referees have reported that several areas cannot be staged effectively. View the current appointments on the <u>SLSNSW event webpage</u> under the relevant Championship.

Furthermore, some officials have indicated that they are able to officiate for only one day of a Championships, which affects the appointments and further impacts on the ability to stage areas effectively.

Quotas:

The original quota memo was issued 18 October 2018

A quota system for Clubs to provide **Accredited Officials** at the NSW State Championships has been in place for a number of years based upon the number of competitors entered into the separate Age, Masters and Opens Championships.

The following is the Officials quota (Age and Opens Championships only).

Clubs are reminded before entering their competitors into the entry system that they MUST meet the Officials' quota.

The following do not currently meet the quota based on the official's appointments. Note that while you may have an official, some have subsequently indicated that they are only able to fulfil limited services. For the interests of the carnival, SLSNSW is not able to attribute this to the quota as it would leave the area short of officials.
