# 2022/23 NSW Surf Boat Interstate Selection Carnivals

Attention:Branch Directors of Surf Sport, Club Presidents, Club Secretaries, Club CompetitionOfficers, Coaches and Surf Boat Competitors

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Summary	SLSNSW is releasing the 2022/23 Surf Boat Interstate Selection Carnivals and selection criteria for the 2023 NSW Surf Boat Interstate Team.
Action	Crews to complete entries with carnival organisers and attend carnivals as listed to be eligible for selection in the NSW Surf Boat Interstate Team.

The SLSA Surfboat Interstate Challenge will be conducted in conjunction with the ASRL Open held on 9 - 12 February 2023. This document outlines the criteria for crews to be selected to represent NSW at the Interstate Challenge on Friday, 10 February 2023.

The NSW State Team will comprise of the following divisions with the selection criteria listed below:

- Open Men
- Open Women
- Under 19 Men
- Under 19 Women
- Under 23 Men
- Under 23 Women
- Reserve Grade Men
- Reserve Grade Women

Please note the above team composition and divisions are based on the 2022/23 Guidelines. SLSNSW reserves the right to alter the team composition at their discretion at any time.

## **Selection Carnivals**

(Please be aware that whilst every effort is being made to run these events, the dates and venues are subject to change. Should this occur notification will be provided as soon as possible)

### State Selection 1 – Port Kembla (Warilla Bowls Surf Boat Premiership – Round 4)

- Saturday 19 November 2022 U19s and U23s
- Sunday 20 November 2022 Opens and Reserves
- Please note, depending on entries, Saturday program may be moved to Sunday

### State Selection 2 – North Cronulla

- Saturday 17 December 2022 U19s and U23s
- Sunday 18 December 2022 Opens and Reserves

## State Selection 3 - North Steyne (SNB Surf Boats - Round 4)

- Saturday 14 January 2023 U19s and U23s
- Sunday 15 January 2023 Opens and Reserves

## **Points Allocation and Selection Criteria**

- a) The top seven crews from each division final at each event above will be allocated points on the following basis: 1st = 7 points, 2nd = 6 points, 3rd = 5 points, 4th = 4 points, 5th = 3 points, 6th = 2 points & 7th = 1 point.
- b) In the event of a crew outside of NSW finishing in the top seven in a division at any of the selection events, the next highest placed NSW crew will be allocated these points. This will continue down until all points have been allocated to NSW crews.
- c) In the case of equal position (i.e. two NSW crews coming 3rd), the points will be allocated based on the position (i.e. 3rd) and the position below (i.e. 4th), the points for those positions will be added together and divided between the two crews (i.e point allocation will be 4.5). The next placed crew will receive the points for the next position (i.e. 5th = 3 points)
- d) Only the points from the crews best two results out of the three selection carnivals will be added together.
- e) The crew/s in each division with the highest number of points at the conclusion of the three events will be deemed as the successful team that will represent NSW at the Interstate Challenge (pending approval).
- f) In the unlikely event that a crew/s is tied on points, the decision will rest with the NSW Surf Boat Panel's recommendation after a review of crews performances to date

#### Competition

Normal competition rules apply as per current SLSA Surf Sports Manual as well as any additional rules imposed by the event organiser.

#### **Team Levy**

All costs (including travel & accommodation) are the responsibility of individuals. SLSNSW will provide a State Team Uniform.

#### **How to Nominate**

- Crews to complete entries with carnival organisers and attend carnivals as listed to be eligible for selection in the NSW Surf Boat Interstate Team.
- Read the SLSA Interstate Rules and Entry Circular (when available)

- All nominating members are asked to familiarise themselves with the SLSNSW Selection Policy and the SLSNSW Athlete & Management Agreement. All athletes will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in these documents.
- All nominees must be current financial members and proficient with their relevant awards. All nominations must be endorsed by both Club and Branch representatives prior to selection – Any nomination that fails to meet these requirements will not be accepted.
- If the selected crew in any division is unable to attend the Australian Interstate Championship, the next highest place crew within that division shall be offered the position (pending approval) and so on as required.
