SLSNSW is seeking nominations for Team Management roles to assist the 2023 NSW Pool Rescue Interstate Team competing at the 2023 Interstate Pool Rescue Championships to be held at Gold Coast Aquatic Centre, Southport, QLD on Friday 4 August 2023. Team Management must also be available to attend training days as arranged.

The roles available for the NSW Interstate Team are

- Lead Coach (x1) 2-year appointment
- Assistant Coach (x1) 2-year appointment
- Team Manager (x1) 2-year appointment

Requirements of Team Management

Desirable experience and attributes for the above Team Management roles include but not limited to:

- SLSNSW strongly encourages both male and female management to nominate, both genders will be represented in management travelling with the Interstate Team.
- Lead and Assistant Coaches to have completed a Development Coach Pool Rescue Award
- Financial SLSC member, endorsed by club & branch.
- Comprehensive knowledge of Surf Sports competition and Pool Rescue rules
- Previous touring experience
- Current First Aid certificate
- Attend all team training sessions.
- Demonstrated ability to think innovatively and strategically.
- Highly motivated and passionate about enhancing the success of NSW Athletes.
- Compile a report within three weeks of completing competition (Team Manager)

Assist with organising various training sessions and development programs for NSW Pool Rescue teams within the appointment period.

How to Nominate

- 1. Read the SLSA Interstate Rules and Entry Circular (when available)
- 2. All nominating members are asked to familiarise themselves with the SLSNSW <u>Selection Policy</u>. All Team Management will be required to comply with the guidelines and expectations set out in this document.
- 3. Applicants will be required to send a brief Curriculum Vitae (CV) and supporting Cover Letter to Jim Pinnington, Surf Sports Manager jpinnington@surflifesaving.com.au by 11pm, 9 June 2023.
- 4. All nominees must be current financial members and hold any relevant awards. All nominations must be endorsed by both Club and Branch representatives prior to selection, please contact your Club and Branch to acquire letters of endorsement Any nomination that fails to meet these requirements will not be accepted.

The appointment period will commence from the date of appointment and will expire 28 days after the 2023 Pool Rescue Interstate Championships.

Team Levy

All costs (including travel & accommodation) are the responsibility of individuals. Selected Team Management may already be attending the Australian Pool Rescue Championships with their club teams.

SLSA Anti-Doping Policy

Surf Life Saving Australia supports the Australian Government, SportAus, the AOC, and the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority (ASADA) in their efforts to eradicate the use of drugs in sport. SLSA has published an Anti-doping Policy, which will be adhered to for this event.

Please be aware that random drug testing by ASADA could take place during the competition. It is highly recommended each State/Territory team member (including management and staff) complete the ASADA online e-learning program (Level 1) to ensure all personnel are aware of contemporary issues pertaining to anti-doping.
