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Summary:	This document is to advise all clubs that Surf Life Saving NSW (SLSNSW) is seeking "Expressions of		
	Interest" (EOI) from Clubs who may wish to host the 2024 NSW Board Riding Championships which		
	is to be held on Saturday 4 May to Sunday 5 May 2024.		
Action:	Complete and submit EOI by Friday 28 July 2023.		

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Introduction

The NSW Board Riding Championships is conducted over two days in May and attracts approximately 300 visitors to the host venue. Competition divisions include Youth, Opens and Masters (male and female). Traditionally, board riding was held as part of the March State Championships, however, to allow this discipline to grow and allow greater flexibility in venue selection, the event became a standalone State Championship in 2015.

SLSNSW is seeking EOIs from Clubs who may be interested in hosting the NSW Board Riding Championships. Successful venues will be chosen from Clubs whose beach meets the venue requirements and favourable consideration will be given for EOIs with strong support from their local board riders club.

SLSNSW will confirm and provide a hosting fee to the successful club. This will be confirmed in the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).

All applications to host this event must have their Club and Branch approval prior to the closing date.

c. Alternative Locations

- The proposed alternative venues should face a different direction and prevailing conditions to that of the proposed venue;
- Two alternative locations should be nominated, with one meeting similar requirements of the proposed venue;
- o Include maps of the proposed alternative venues;
- o Sufficient power supplies installed for all temporary infrastructure;
- o Sufficient plumbing and associated hot water service located at the alternative venue.

d. Other Logistical Requirements

- o Accessible to adequate emergency services including hospital and ambulance service;
- o Access to medical, pharmaceutical, dental, physio and chiropractic services;
- The venue must be available to SLSNSW prior to and after the event to allow for event erection and dismantle;
- A designated car park and/or on street parking of 50 spaces;
- Provide an overview of facilities in the area including shopping centres, entertainment facilities, public transport and accommodation;

Checklist for Host Venue

Prospective Host Venue to complete checklist.

Essential Criteria

- ✓ Support from local board riders club with provision of judges and use of timing/judging systems
- ✓ Sufficient length and width of unobstructed beach with close proximity to club and facilities
- ✓ Local government support (in writing). The event application must be completed by the host Council and SLSNSW however please make enquiries with local council for provisional approval for the dates indicated.
- ✓ Sufficient workforce for the duration of the event (5x minimum)
- ✓ Available accommodation within a reasonable distance from the venue
- ✓ Public & judging viewing areas
- ✓ Proximity to a shopping complex
- ✓ A suitable alternative venue in the event of adverse sea conditions (within a reasonable distance from the proposed venue)
- ✓ A minimum of 1 operational IRB, driver, and crew suitable for laying cans and water safety
- ✓ Provide catering for the carnival
- ✓ First Aid (minimum 2 personnel with 1 personnel holding spinal management qualification as a minimum)
- ✓ ATV/4WD vehicles as required for the event
- ✓ Club and Branch endorsement
- ✓ Detailed map outlining the site layout



Desirable Criteria

- √ Gear storage areas
- ✓ 4 x tents
- ✓ Waste and recycling bins with regular cleaning
- ✓ Surf club facilities for Officials briefing/debrief
- ✓ Officials catering and refreshment facilities (30 Officials)
- ✓ Power supply
- ✓ Drinking water
- ✓ Nearby public or other toilet facilities

Clubs must also make contact with their Council to provide notification that a Surf Life Saving competition could be staged on the nominated dates. This is to avoid any event clashes with any other beach users/event organisers. A formal Event Application will need to be submitted to Council by the successful Host Club.
