- Financial SLSC member, endorsed by club & branch.
- Comprehensive knowledge of Surf Sports competition and rules
- Previous touring experience
- Current First Aid certificate
- Attend all team training sessions.
- Demonstrated ability to think innovatively and strategically.
- Highly motivated and passionate about enhancing the success of NSW Athletes.
- Compile a report within three weeks of completing competition (Team Manager)

It is highly recommended all team members (including coaches, competitors, and support personnel) complete the SIA online e-learning program (Level 1) to ensure all personnel are aware of contemporary issues pertaining to anti-doping.
