Junior carnival (U8 to U13) commences at 8:30am

and Senior & Masters (U14 to Masters) commence 12:30pm

Note: Under 14s will be competing with the Seniors and Masters.

1. ENTRIES:

1.1 Entries to be completed by clubs on-line through [SLSA SEMS](#). **Please go to carnival named Sydney Water Surf Series 2024 (This will enter the competitor into ALL 4 rounds)**

1.2 All competitors must meet SLSNSW or respective state, award, patrol and proficiency requirements as per 2024/25 proficiency competition requirements including Policy 5.04 and any other subsequent bulletins issued.

1.3 **2024-2025 Junior proficiencies for competitors must be entered into Surfguard prior to entries being submitted into SEMS.** ANY COMPETITORS THAT DO NOT MEET CRITERIA WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE.

1.4 Entries will close at midnight, Tuesday 15 October 2024.

2. ENTRY FEES:

2.1 \$80.00 per competitor.

2.2 The entry fee includes an official race singlet and covers entry to **any or all rounds** of the series.

2.3 Please bring your liveheats wristband. If you require a new one, they will be available to purchase.

2.4 All Under 8 competitors will receive a sample/gift bag at the end of the series. Under 8s will not require liveheats wristband.

3. LATE ENTRIES

3.1 Late entries will be taken on the day of each carnival but will attract an additional fee of \$20 per competitor. If a member is unable to be entered into SEMS on the day of entry, their entry may not be accepted.

4. RASH VESTS

4.1 Sponsored rash vests will be given to each competitor as part of their entry fee. This rash vest must be worn during competition by all competitors (surf and beach).

4.2 Club to complete Rash Vest order by **Tuesday 15 October 2024**. All attempts will be made to give correct sizes as per order but will depend on pre-ordered stock. To place order, go to [2024 Sydney Water Surf Series Rash Vest Order Form](#)

5. SERIES FORMAT:

- 5.1 The Sydney Water Surf Series will be conducted over 4 rounds and open to any SLSA financial and proficient member.
- 5.2 Under 8 events will be held but we will not be conducting a pointscore in this age group. All under 8 competitors will receive a sample/gift bag at the last round.
- 5.3 Under 14s will compete in the afternoon program.
- 5.4 Individual point score championships will be conducted for age categories from Under 9 to Masters.
- 5.5 The categories for Under 9's through to Under 17's shall be:
- a) Male Water Championship – points accrued from their individual age group water events
 - b) Female Water Championship – points accrued from their individual age group water events
 - c) Male Beach Championship – points accrued from their individual age group beach events
 - d) Female Beach Championship – points accrued from their individual age group beach events
- 5.6 Under 19's and Opens will compete jointly in open events. Cash/prizes will be awarded to winners in each round and overall series winners.
- 5.7 Masters categories will be 30yrs to 49yrs and 50yrs and over.
- a) Male Water Championship – points accrued from their individual Masters age group water events.
 - b) Female Water Championship – points accrued from their individual Masters age group water events.
 - c) Male Beach Championship – points accrued from their individual Masters age group water events.
 - d) Female Beach Championship – points accrued from their individual Masters age group water events
- 5.8 **Prize Pool** for 2024 will be over \$60,000.
- 5.9 **INSURANCE:** As Sydney Water Surf Series offers prizes/prizemoney to individual competitors, please note that means that the competitor is only covered under typical personal accident/injury. They are not covered under iCare (workers compensation).

6. POINTSCORE:

6.1 Points to be given in each race in each round:

Placing	Points @ Round
1 st	10
2 nd	8
3 rd	7
4 th	6
5 th	5
6 th	4
7 th	3
8 th	2

6.2 **Count back** - In the circumstance of two or more competitors finishing on equal points in the overall pointscore, a countback will occur to determine which competitor receives the higher placing in the overall pointscore. The countback will be awarded to the competitor who has the highest individual event placing or number of placings in all rounds. If both competitors have the same number of highest placings (e.g. three 1st places in individual round events) then the next highest position (e.g. number of 2nd placings) will be used to separate the competitors.

7. PAYMENT:

7.1 SLS Illawarra will issue invoices to clubs after closing date of Tuesday 15 October 2024 of which will be due in 14 days. If a club has not paid their entry fees by Round 4, prizes may not be given out to their competitors.

7.2 Entry fees are not refundable if members do not take part in this series or if a round/s are cancelled.

8. PROGRAM:

8.1 See attached program which is subject to change under the direction of the Carnival Referee.

8.2 Team events will be OPEN (meaning male and/or female) unless stated otherwise. Team Events will only be held if time permits.

8.3 Events will be conducted as per the current SLSA Surf Sports Manual Edition and any additional bulletins.

8.4 It will be up to the discretion of the Carnival Committee if events go ahead or be changed.

9. LIVEHEATS/WRISTBANDS

9.1 LiveHeats RFID technology will be utilised at Sydney Water Surf Series. All athletes from U9 to Masters must wear their wristband in all events. It will help with marshalling, delivering live results and communication. Please bring your SLS NSW or SLSA liveheats wristband not your Boardriders or Lifesaving World Championships wristband.

9.2 Competitors with Liveheats wristbands do not need to check in at Administration. Competitors without Liveheats wristbands need to come to administration. For new competitors (ie those who have not previously registered in Live Heats), wristband is included in their entry fee. For those competitors requiring a new or replacement wristband, they can be purchased from Administration for a fee of \$10.00.

9.3 Under 8s need to check in at administration to receive their wristband (not Liveheats).

NO WRISTBAND, NO COMPETITION

Wristbands will not be given to Managers/Parents – Competitors must come to Administration for the wristband to be sized correctly and issued with their wristband.

10. IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE:

10.1 **ALL** competitors (surf and beach) **MUST** wear official Sydney Water Surf Series singlets during competition. The competitor must wear Hi-Vis rash vest during warm-up period in water as well.

10.2 All handlers must wear Hi-Vis rash vest, club competition cap and must be a financial member of their club.

10.3 There will be two designated warm up areas on the day before the carnival – one area for board warm-up & one area for swim warm-up. Competitors must wear Hi-Vis rash vest during warm-up.

10.4 Individual clubs will be responsible for the water safety of their own competitors during the warm-up period.

10.5 All competitors must have their age group written clearly on their arms.

10.6 **OFFICIAL COMMUNICATION** will be via Stack Team App – Sydney Water Surf Series and emails. Please advise all your competitors to join Stack Team App. We will put updates on Facebook and Instagram.

11. OFFICIALS/WATER SAFETY:

11.1 Each club competing in the Sydney Water Surf Series must supply:

a) **OFFICIALS: 1 official per 7 competitors** Clubs are expected to supply officials in accordance with the split between their senior and junior entries.

b) **WATER SAFETY: 1 person per every 7 competitors** – required for U8-U13 section of carnival and U14 events. (Water Safety personal is in addition to Officials)

In calculating this rule, please note that the above quota for water safety is for the total number of competitors not the total number of water competitor's e.g. 1 official and 1 water safety personnel for 1 through to 7 competitors, 2 officials and 2 water safety personnel for 8 – 14 competitors;

So for example if a club has 30 competitors in total they require 5 officials and 5 water safety personal.

11.2 Sydney Water Surf Series Committee is calling for Expressions of Interest from members to fulfil official roles at each round. This is an ongoing strategy that will help develop more officials and have a pathway for them to take on leading roles at major championships. We will attempt to accommodate all requests but can not guarantee. A roster will be published before each round on Stack Team App.

This form can be submitted at any time during the series but please try and have submitted by Tuesday before each round so rosters can be completed a timely manner.

11.3 Rosters for both officials and water safety will be done and placed in Team App by Thursday prior to each round. It is club's responsibility to fulfill their obligations as per the Roster. These ratios will be strictly adhered to by the Carnival Referee.

11.4 All officials and water safety personnel will be required to "sign on and off" on the day.

**ALL OFFICIALS AND WATER SAFETY PERSONNEL MUST BE FINANCIAL MEMBERS OF SURF LIFE SAVING
AND HAVE THE APPROPRIATE QUALIFICATIONS FOR THEIR ROLE.**

12. HEALTH & WELLBEING:

12.1 Competitors and officials should realise the importance of fitness to undertake their respective activities and should seek expert advice on all aspects of their health before participating. Competitors and/or officials who suffer illness or injury should seek medical advice prior to participating or continuing with their activity.

12.2 In addition SLS Illawarra may, at its sole discretion, require a competitor and/or official to be assessed for physical and/or psychological fitness to participate to ensure that an unfit competitor and/or official and/or SLS Illawarra is not placed at risk.

13. BEHAVIOUR/MISCONDUCT:

13.1 Misconduct before, during and after the Championships will not be tolerated and offending member's risk disciplinary action against themselves and their Clubs.

13.2 Please refer to current Surf Sports Manual sections 2.27 SLSA Code of Behaviour and 2.28 Abuse/Inappropriate Behaviour and SLSA Policy 6.5 – Member Protection Policy

14. CLUB DECLARATION, TEAM MANAGER DETAILS, RASH VEST ORDER and EOI FOR OFFICIALS:

14.1 A Club Executive Officer must fill out the Club Declaration and Team Managers Details by **Tuesday 15 October 2024**.
