OFFICIAL REQUIREMENTS

Surf Life Saving NSW is looking for accredited Officials who meet the following requirements:

- Are a current financial member of a club for 2024/25 season.
- Hold a minimum of a current Technical Official accreditation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- All Officials to ensure that they are physically capable to carry out their important functions over the days of the Championships and are encouraged to undertake a medical check prior to the Championships.
- All appointed Officials are encouraged to attend the Official's Briefings. All times and locations will be outlined in the Officials Appointment Memo.
- Appointed Officials are responsible for all costs associated with travel and accommodation for the Championships.
- Officials are expected to wear a SLSNSW Championships Officials shirt.
- While every effort is made to appoint you to your preferred position, it is not always possible to do so. All appointments will be posted on the event page.
- Officials will be allocated to available positions. If the number of nominations exceed the positions available, those not selected will be placed into the 'Officials Pool' and positions may be allocated if they become available.
- Any late nominations will also be placed into the 'Officials Pool' and positions may be allocated if they become available.

IRB OFFICIALS QUOTA

To support the on-going delivery and development of IRB competition, a quota will be based on a Clubs individual entries per Round/Championship to grow the number of IRB technical officials.

Clubs without sufficient currently accredited officials are advised that members should be encouraged to complete the online Technical Officials course. The face-to-face assessments can be run during the Premiership rounds.

Members who have completed the online course will count towards the quota for the Premiership, however, must be accredited to count for the State IRB Championships.
